Photo 1

Photo 2

After the first trips of Bands on a Boat on Friday, you will slowly see more and more sailor hats appear in the city, so even if you're not aboard the ship, this shouldn't be too hard to do: take a photo of someone wearing an original Left of the Dial sailor hat. (Just be sure to ask permission, randomly photographing people is creepy!)

Photo 3

Some people hate them, some people feel Left of the Dial wouldn't be complete without them: the inflatable tube guys. Also known as sky dancers, wappermannen, or the waving wrestlers. Now, we don't want a snapshot of just any tube guy... look up and find the one that is placed on a tall building and take its picture.
